**ORDER AUTHORIZING CHILD TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS FOR MOTOR
VEHICLE INSURANCE BEFORE THE CHILD'S 18TH BIRTHDAY**

THIS CAUSE came before the court to remove the disabilities of nonage of _____ for the purpose of entering into agreements to secure motor vehicle insurance pursuant to 39.701 (3)(a), Florida Statutes. The court being fully advised in the premises FINDS as follows:

1. _____ (hereinafter, "the child") is 16 years of age or older.
2. The child has completed a driver education program.
3. The child meets the requirements of section 743.047, Florida Statutes, and is entitled to the benefits of the statute.

THEREFORE, based on these findings of fact, it is ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

1. The disabilities of nonage of the child are hereby removed for the purposes of entering into agreements to secure motor vehicle insurance.
2. _____ is hereby authorized to make and execute documents, contracts, agreements, and all other instruments necessary for the purpose of obtaining motor vehicle insurance.
3. Execution of any such contract or agreement for motor vehicle insurance made by the child has the same effect as if it were the act of a person who is not a minor.
